

# COULD THIS BE *YOUR* HAPPIEST DAY

?

*Jesus said, I am The Way, The Truth and The Life, no man cometh unto The Father but by Me. John 14 v 6.*

*Jesus says “Verily, verily I say unto thee, except a man be ‘born again’ he cannot see the Kingdom of God.” John 3 v 3.*

*...The Blood of Jesus Christ, God’s Son, cleanseth us from all sin. 1 John 1 v 7.*

During a recent visit to London, we sat at Trafalgar Square one afternoon, just watching people. All kinds and conditions of men, women, boys and girls - different nationalities, rich, poor, etc. - but all with one thing in common - either *saved* or *unsaved*. Of course, all around us the situation is the same. Vast numbers of people give no thought whatsoever to God or the life hereafter.

If you read this leaflet and you are not saved, we would urge you to seriously consider your position before God. You might ask, 'Saved from what?' Saved from the wrath of God and eternal damnation in that awful place called Hell.

We are living in dark and dangerous days, when Biblical prophecy is being fulfilled at a furious pace. Every day we hear of terrible atrocities taking place with crime and murder on the increase. Wars, Famines, Diseases and Disasters are escalating daily. Extreme weather change causing earthquakes, hurricanes, tornadoes, and flooding. To the other extreme, heat and drought, forest fires etc. causing devastation on a horrendous scale. All of these events making us aware that the second-coming of The Lord Jesus Christ is near. Read Matthew 24. Mark 13. Luke 21.

*The Bible says, that before Jesus returns: There shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of Heaven shall be shaken.....*

*When these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh. Luke 21 v 25 - 28.*

Jesus *is* coming soon !! If He were to return today, or if you were to die today - are you prepared to meet Him? Can you say with assurance and confidence from your heart, that you have trusted Him as your Lord and Saviour?

Some people will say: I don't agree with this 'being saved.' I go to my Church or I go to Mass every Sunday. I have been baptized and confirmed. I am a good person. I am doing the best I can. I don't think God will keep me out of Heaven.

My dear friend how wrong you are. If Church-going or good works had been enough to get you into Heaven - Jesus would not have died on the cross. You will *only* get into Heaven by trusting Him as your Saviour, *repenting of your sins* and acknowledging His sacrificial death for you. To be cleansed in His Blood, to be 'born again' and living in the *Resurrection Victory* of the *finished work* of Calvary - is absolutely essential.

Baptism, Confirmation etc. - none of these Ordinances will get you into Heaven. You will only get into Heaven when you make Jesus a reality in your life - by earnestly repenting of your sin and trusting Him as your Saviour. In other words, The Blood of Jesus which was shed for you at Calvary must be applied to your life. As the Hymn-writer put it - What can wash away my sin? Nothing but The Blood of Jesus.

If you have read this far and you are saying to yourself “I couldn’t do this – it wouldn’t work for me - I’m too bad - I have too many problems.” Jesus says:-

*He that cometh to me, I will in no wise cast out. John 6 v. 37.*

*...The blood of Jesus Christ, God’s Son, cleanseth us from all sin. 1 John 1 v. 7.  
..though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow. Isaiah 1 v 16.*

Are you feeling down, depressed, unwanted, unloved - in despair of any kind? Is your life in a mess – you feel just cannot go on – do you feel suicidal? You may have financial problems - problems with personal relationships – marriage difficulties. You may have problems with children in one way or another. You may be bringing up a Family on your own and finding it difficult.

Are you caught in the trap of the occult, sexual immorality, drink, drugs, violence or terrorism? Are you homosexual – maybe suffering from the dreaded A.I.D.S? Perhaps you are a young person experiencing difficulties at home or at school - you have no one you can call a real friend - you may be suffering the effects of some form of abuse - life is hard - you feel isolated and alone. Maybe you’re trying to cope with harassment in your workplace and finding it impossible. Take your burden to The Lord in Prayer. The list of problems may be endless but please try to grasp the reality that, ‘Nothing is impossible with God.’

**No matter who you are - no matter what your problem - large or small  
Jesus cares. Call upon Him. He will help you.**

If you feel at the end of the road - no one can help - no one cares - **Jesus cares.**

Maybe you are ‘well-off’ financially. You have no problems of any kind. Life is just great. You think this ‘being saved’ is not for you - it is dull and a load of rubbish.

Remember that The Bible says, the day will come when *every* knee shall bow and *every* tongue shall confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God The Father.

*Jesus says, What shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world  
and lose his own soul? Mark 8 v. 36.*

**Jesus loves you - He died for you - He longs for you to trust Him as your Saviour.**

If you now realise the truth and you truly want to belong to The Lord Jesus Christ, then, simply pray earnestly from your heart. The following is a Prayer for guidelines, but please remember, unless you are totally sincere and repentant of your sins, this Prayer will *not* save you. So make sure every word you pray is genuine.

## **SINCERE PRAYER TO THE LORD FOR SALVATION.**

**Dear Lord Jesus Christ, I come humbly and sincerely before you now, acknowledging that I am a sinner in need of your great Salvation. I believe that you are The Son of God - that you shed your blood on the cruel cross of Calvary that I might be saved. It is important that I remember that without *repentance* there is no forgiveness of sin - so right now I earnestly *repent* and turn away from all my sins, asking you in your mercy to please forgive me. From this day forward I want to walk in newness of life, and in obedience to your Commandments. All this I earnestly pray from my heart, and by faith I receive you now as my Lord and Saviour. I believe that I am now 'born again' - that my name has now been written in Heaven in The Book of Life. Please fill me with your Holy Spirit and help me to confess Your Name and my Salvation before others?  
Thank you Lord Jesus. Amen.**

Having said this prayer with sincerity in your heart - the first most important thing you must do - is tell someone - your Minister - Pastor - or some 'born again' Believer who will help you as you step into your new life with The Lord Jesus Christ.

Don't be afraid to confess your Salvation to others. Pray and read The Bible every day. Get involved in a good Bible-believing Church. For your growth in 'The Faith' it is most important that you attend the Prayer Meetings with other Believers.

Protestant, Roman Catholic - no matter what your Religion, creed, class or social standing - *You need Jesus in your life - without Salvation you are a lost soul.*

**Commit your life to The Lord Jesus Christ today.  
Make this the 'Happiest Day' of your life.**
